- Increase the percentage of Prep-Year 3 students attaining or exceeding the following end of year reading benchmarks:

Prep	100% PM Level 9	50% PM Level 12
Year 1	100% PM Level 19	50% PM Level 22
Year 2	100% PM Level 25	50% PM Level 28
Year 3	80% PM Level 28	20% PM Level 30

- Ensure that every student achieves C or above in core subjects, or has an evidence-based learning plan enacted.
- Improve Year 3 and 5 NAPLAN Writing results with 20% of students achieving results in the Upper Two Bands (U2B).

Our initiatives include

- Refine and enhance the current P-3 reading program to include explicit teaching of oral language, phonics, phonemic awareness, vocabulary, fluency and comprehension.
- Provide focused and intensive teaching to students requiring support to demonstrate year level achievement standards.
- Support teachers to effectively use data to inform targeted teaching and learning.
- Develop a whole school approach to evaluate student writing.
- Build teacher knowledge and understanding of the critical aspects of the Literacy Continuum.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Purchase 0.24 FTE class teacher to maintain three classes in the school, ensuring that teaching is focused and learning supported.
